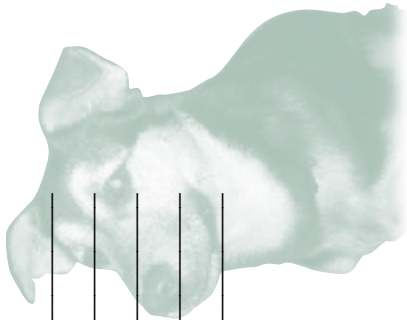

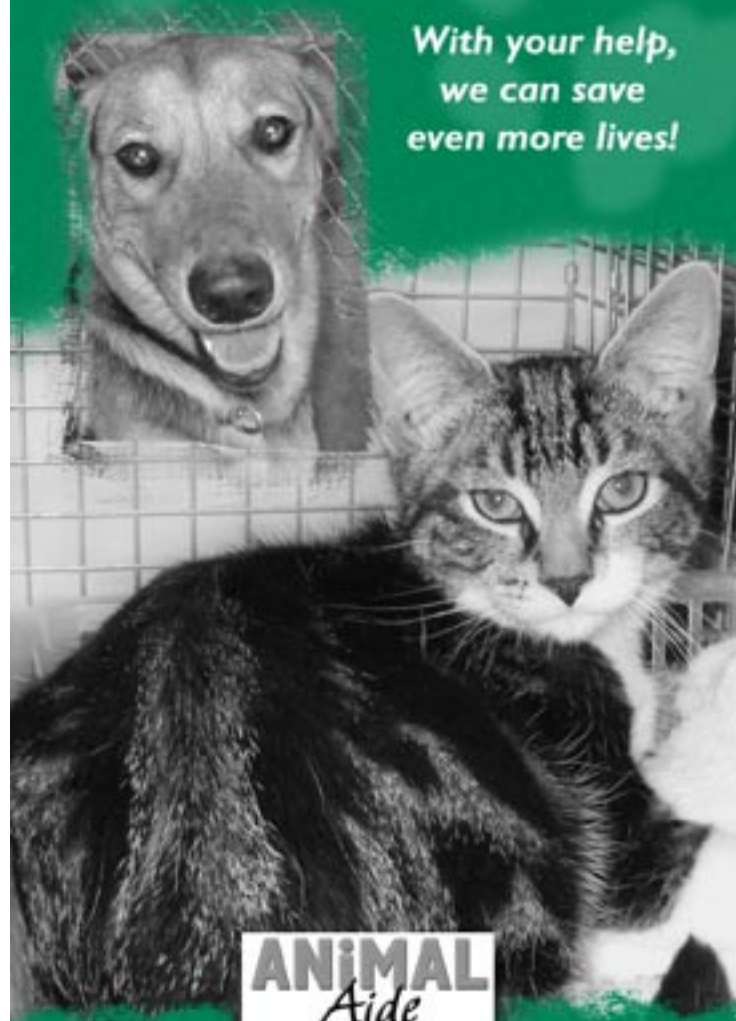

### Saving lives

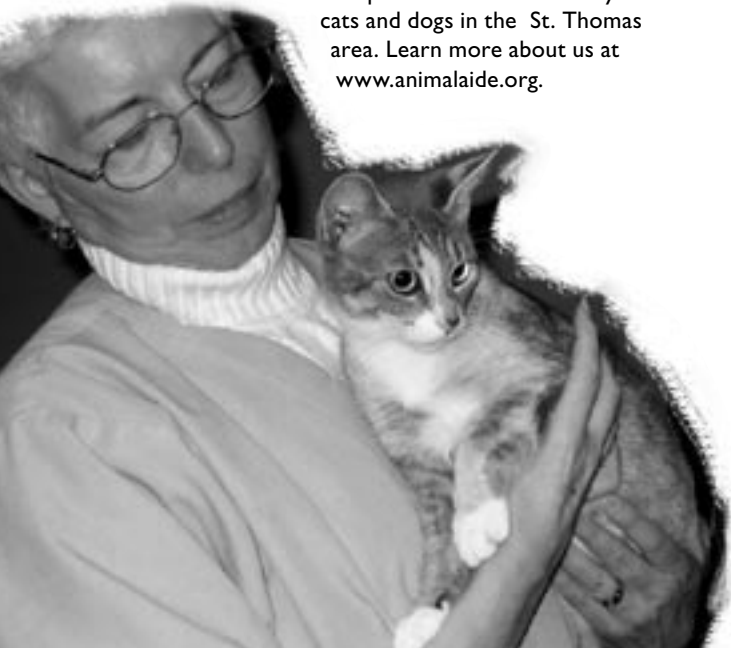

All cats and dogs are vaccinated and adult animals are spayed or neutered before adoption.
